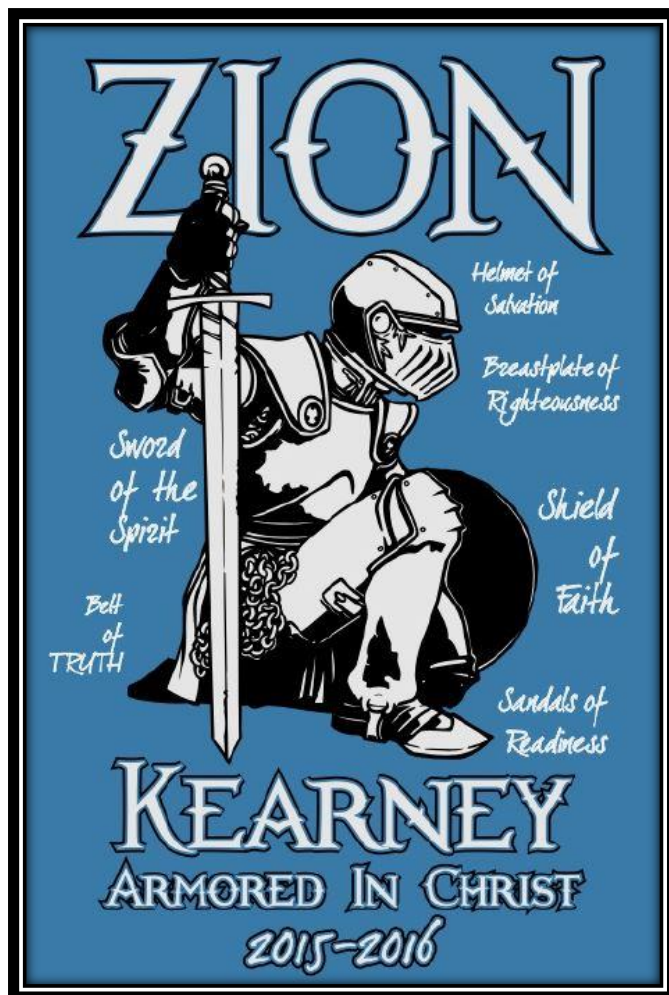

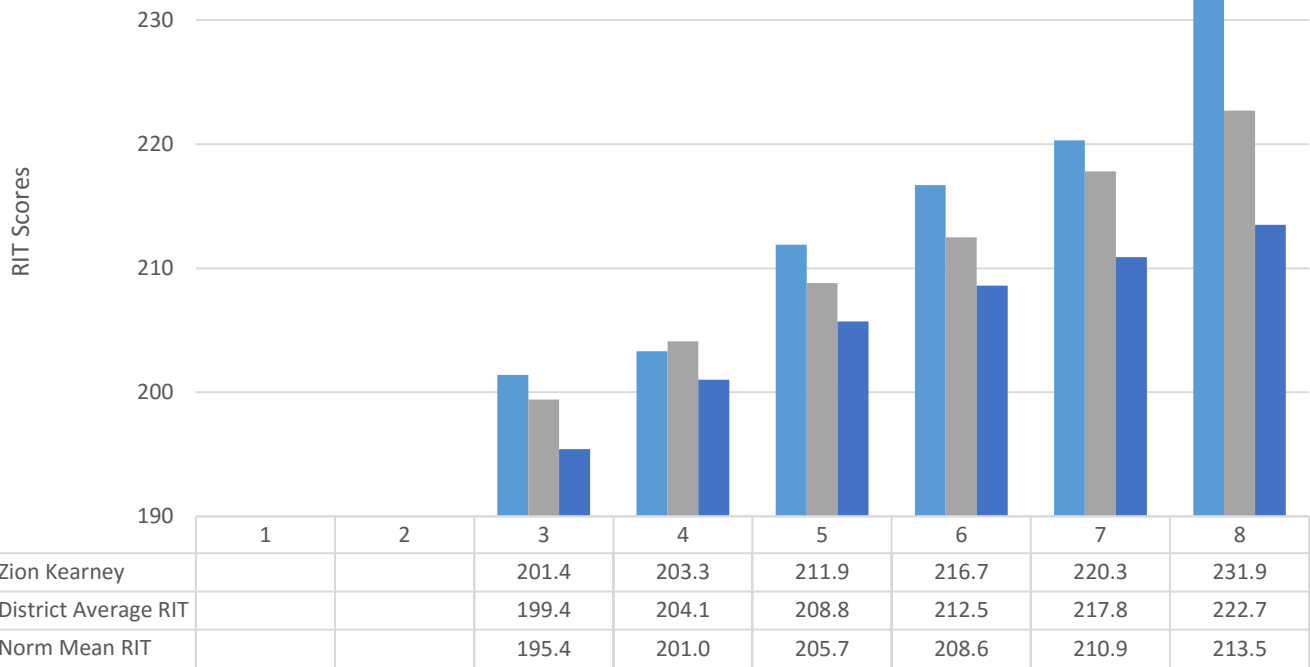

A COMPARISON OF AVERAGES

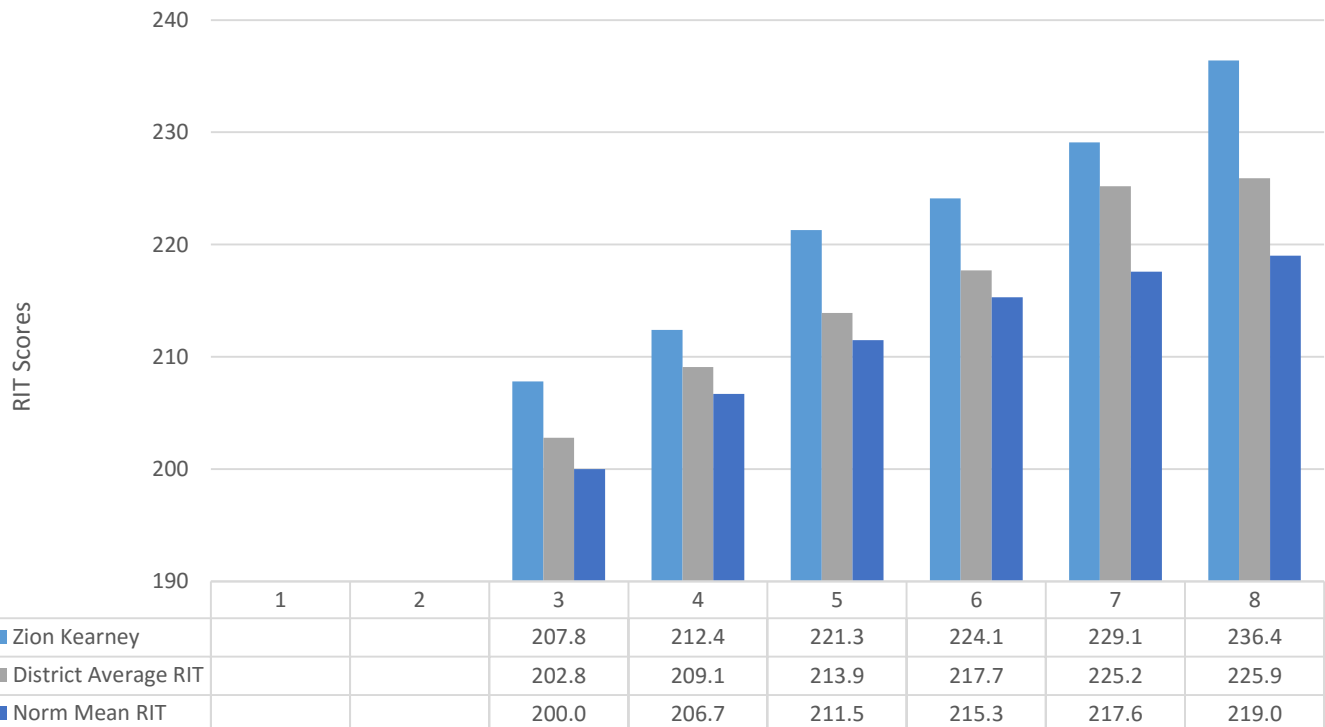
How does Zion Lutheran School compare to other schools academically? Zion uses the NWEA MAP assessment to gauge student learning. This test is given in fall, winter, and spring testing sessions and gives teachers, students, and families immediate feedback on achievement. The MAP assessment has become the assessment of choice for the Lutheran schools of the Nebraska district and is also administered by Kearney Public Schools. This uniformity of testing allows us now to better compare school achievement using classroom averages. This document will illustrate how Zion compares with other Lutheran schools and students nationally.

2015-2016 NWEA MAP Results: Science Zion Kearney vs. Nebraska Dist. vs. Nation

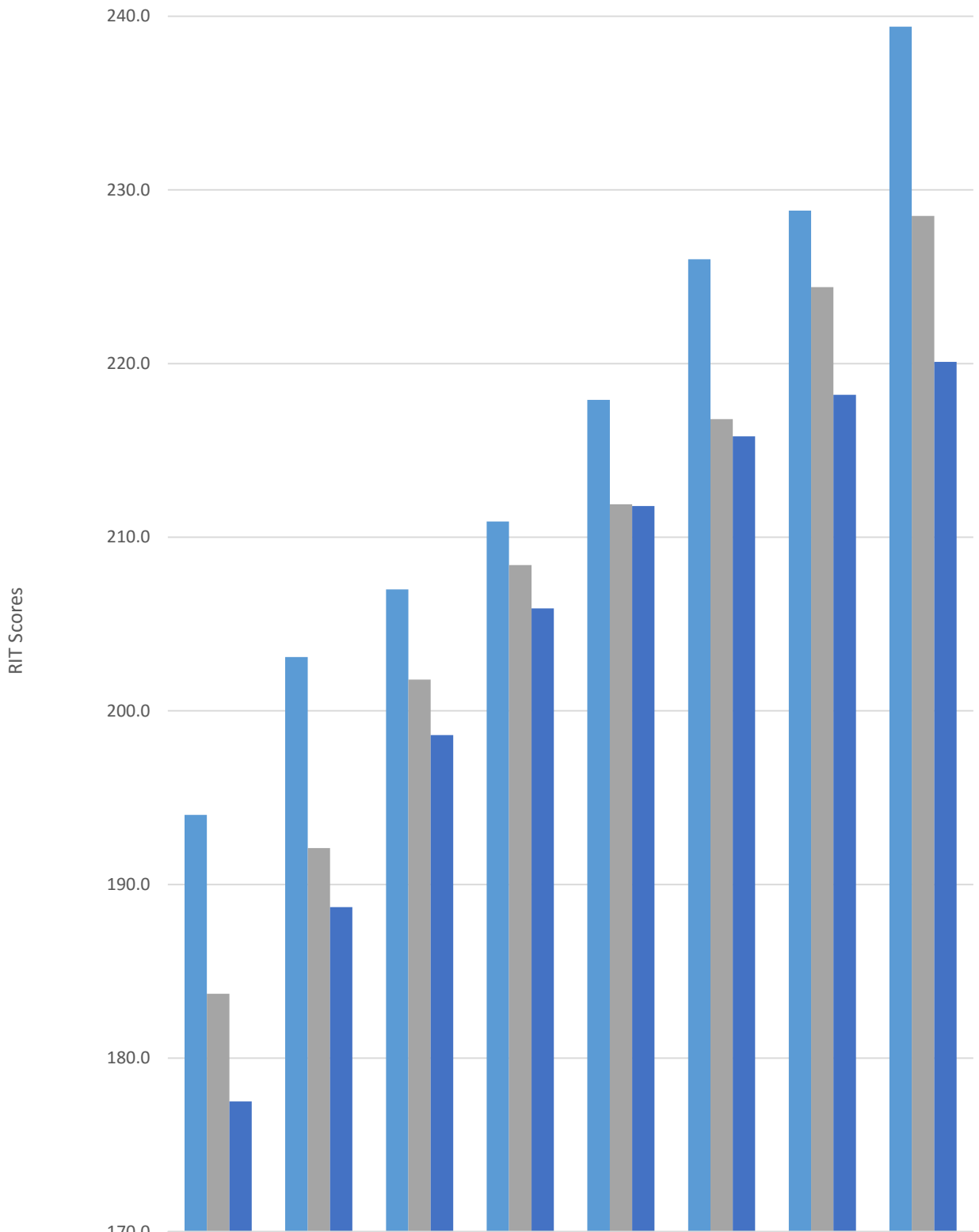


2015-2016 NWEA MAP Results: Language Arts Zion Kearney vs. Nebraska Dist. vs. Nation



- Please note that 1st and 2nd grade students are not tested in the areas of science and language arts.

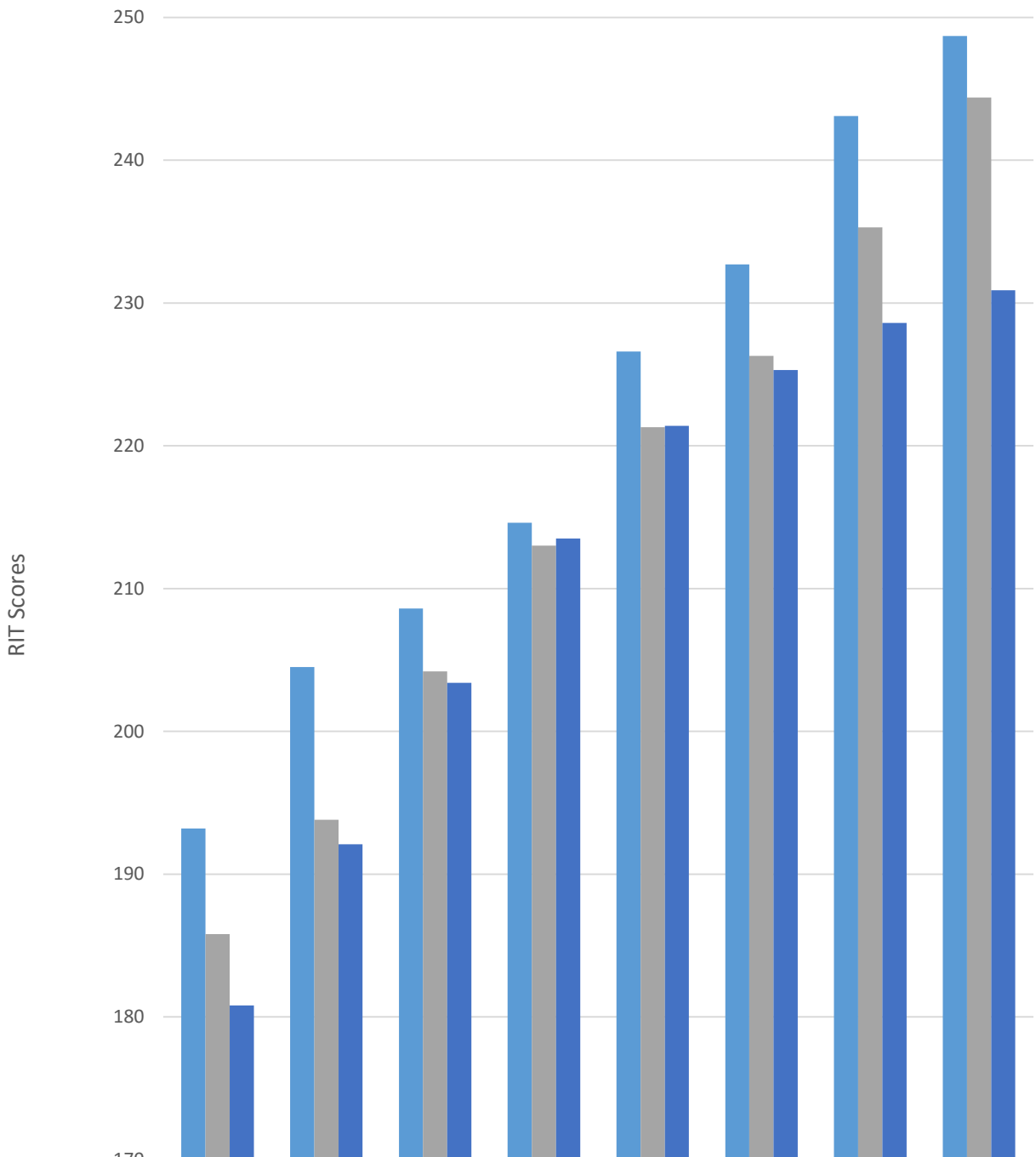
